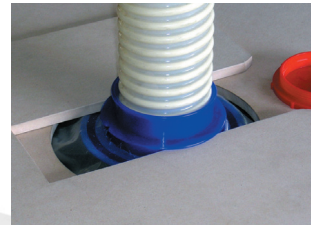
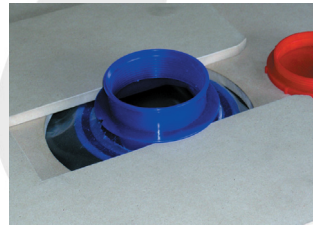
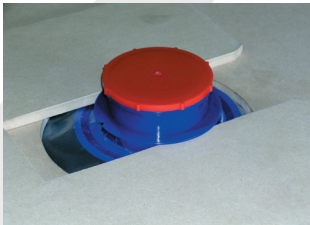
Internal lining
